- Additionally there are "0 Judge Candidate" and "RA" – Rules Advisor

What is a Judge Level?

- The Judge Level indicates
 - Responsibility
 - Skills and Experience
 - Role
- Higher Levels require higher time commitment especially outside tournaments

History of Judge Levels

- "early" age (until 2004)
 - First official definition of Judge Levels, higher Level often meant "more experienced judge"
- "middle" age (2005 2011)
 - First redefinition of Judge Levels: "Rise to your Responsibilities"
- "modern" age (2011)
 Redefinitions of Level 1 3: "Find your Role"
